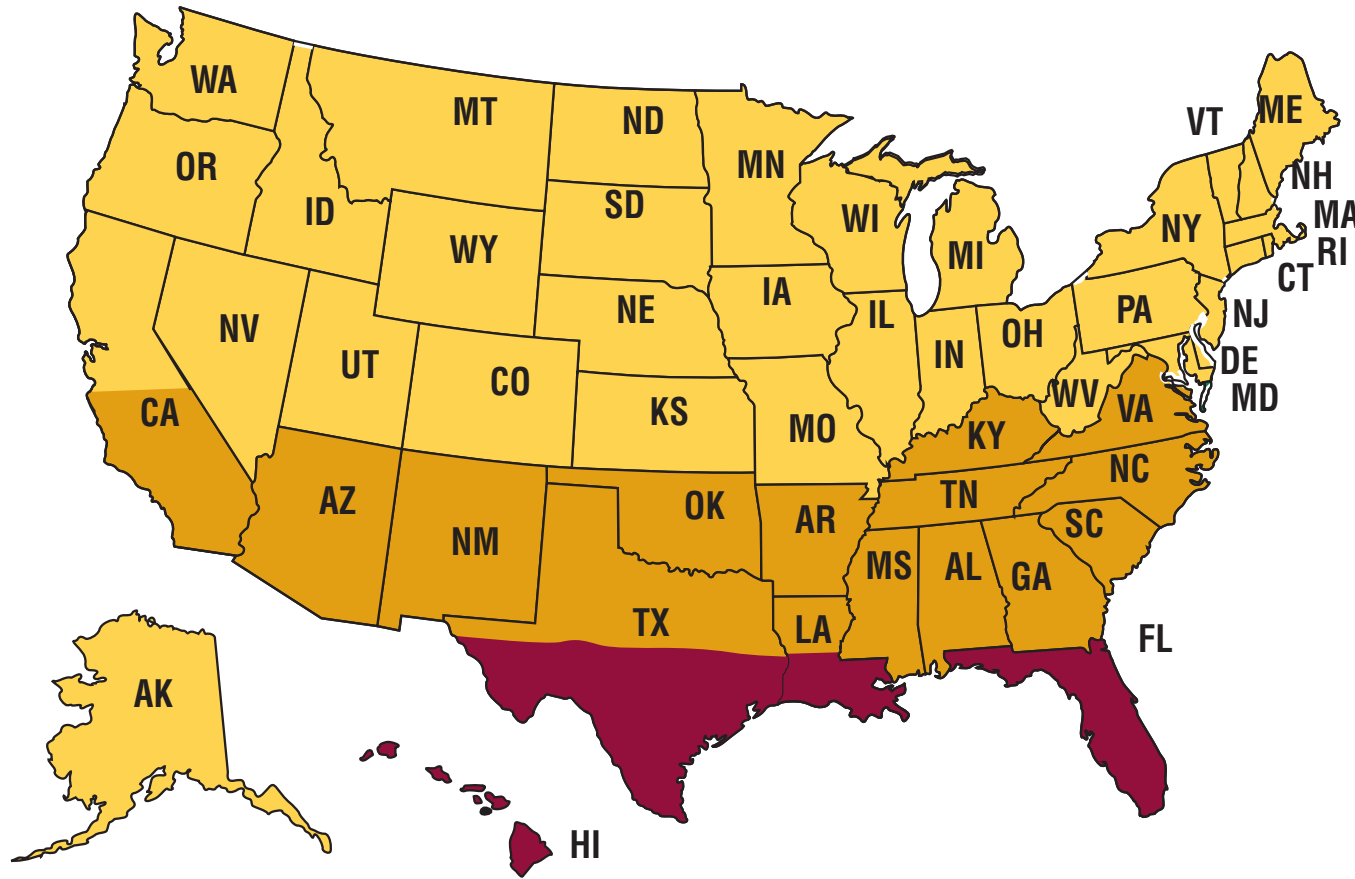


# R-Values for Enhanced Home Energy Savings and Comfort

The map shows NAIMA's recommended thermal insulation levels based on both the U.S. Department of Energy's recommendations and the most recent minimum International Energy Conservation Code levels.
